With reference to your letter of the 5th instant, respecting certificates for the m.v "FOYLEBANK", I feel sure there must be some mistake, as all the certificates you mention have already been issued to you.

On the 4th December last you asked for the certificate for the Special Survey which had recently taken place on the ship at Belfast, and accordingly those on the Hull, Machinery and Donkey Boiler were issued to you on the 7th December.

The Refrigerating Machinery Certificate for the record + Lloyds RMC10,39 was sent to you on the 16th October, 1939, and the Loadline certificate was sent to Belfast to be placed on board on the 5th October.

I think I should also point out that the records of these surveys, and also that of the tailshaft, were posted in the Register Book at the time.

Trusting that you will find there has been an oversight and that this explanation will enable you to find the certificates.
