**ENEMY AIRCRAFT SINK H.M. TRAWLER**

The Admiralty issued the following official communique last evening:—

The Secretary of the Admiralty regrets to announce that H.M. trawler *Cape Finisterre* (temporary Skipper J. P. Grantham, R.N.R.) has been lost in an action with enemy aircraft. H.M. trawler *Cape Finisterre* was attacked by four enemy aircraft on Friday evening. The first aircraft to attack was shot down into the sea but the *Cape Finisterre* suffered damage from the attacks of the remaining three enemy aircraft and subsequently sank. The next-of-kin of casualties have been informed.
