ENEMY AIRCRAFT SINK H.M. TRAWLER

The Admiralty issued the following official communique last evening:—
The Secretary of the Admiralty regrets to announce that H.M. trawler Cape Finisterre (temporary Skipper J. P. Grantham, R.N.R.) has been lost in an action with enemy aircraft. H.M. trawler Cape Finisterre was attacked by four enemy aircraft on Friday evening. The first aircraft to attack was shot down into the sea but the Cape Finisterre suffered damage from the attacks of the remaining three enemy aircraft and subsequently sank. The next-of-kin of casualties have been informed.
