Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 1st instant, respecting the fees to be charged for the first entry survey on the S.S. "CLEANTON", Messrs. Richardson Buck & Co's No. 677 vessel (your first entry report No. 10491), I have to inform you that as this Steamer has been completed to the specification of a Standard Vessel, the fees should be charged as for a Standard Vessel.

In this case, as the gross tonnage is 5219, the total fees will be £347. 18. 8, the hull portion being £231. 19. 2 and the machinery £115. 19. 6. You will therefore be good enough to render an account to the Builders accordingly.

I may say that these fees have been entered on your first entry report.

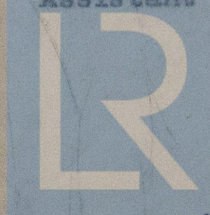
