Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 23rd January respecting the S.S. "CLAN MACFARLANE", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting today the Surveyors' Reports from which it appears that to complete the machinery survey the following remains to be done:-

L.P. and M.P. top and bottom ends, H.P. bottom end, main bearings, crank shaft, intermediate shafts, coned end of exhaust turbine shaft, ballast transfer and general service pumps to be examined and main and auxiliary steam pipes to be tested to Rule requirements.

I may add that the Boiler Survey has been carried out at this time.

No opportunity was afforded for the hull survey to be further advanced.
