I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle-on-Tyne have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 12th instant regarding the amount of the fee charged for the Annual Freeboard Survey which was recently carried out on this vessel in their district. In reply I am directed to point out that the fee charged for the Annual Loadline Survey, namely, £3.0.0., was strictly in accordance with the Statutory Schedule of Fees, viz:- £2.0.0. plus £1.0.0. for the additional visit necessary to inspect the completion of the renewals recommended by the Surveyors. These renewals were independent of the survey made for the damage resulting from grounding, and the account was therefore quite in order.
