

When this steamer was in Batavia on the 7th. June, it was found on overhauling the Coupling between the Turbine and the Tunnel Shaft, that a longitudinal crack had developed, and your Surveyor, resident in that port, was called in by the Captain.

The cablegrams received by us regarding the repair were discussed with your principal Surveyors here, as we could not agree with the recommendations put forward by your Batavia Surveyor.

We are enclosing extracts of letters received, as we consider the whole position should be known to you.

We shall be glad to receive your views, as we are not satisfied with the attitude taken up by your Batavia Surveyor.
