With reference to the survey which has recently been held here on the above vessel, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their meeting to-day the Surveyors' Reports, from which it appears that the Special Survey No. 3, which became due in December last, has been further advanced, and the following now remains to be done to complete the inspection, viz:-

HULL: Anchors, chain locker, and windlass to be examined.  
Oil fuel cross bunkers to be tested under pressure.

MACHINERY: Sea connections, M.P. & L.P. cylinders and pistons, all pumps, pumping arrangement, steam pipes and electric installation to be examined.

It is understood to be your intention to complete this survey on the vessel's return in about four months' time, and I have the pleasure to say that this arrangement has been agreed to by the Committee.

The Boiler Survey has been completely held at this time, and a certificate will be forwarded to you in due course.
