I am in receipt of your letter of the 29th instant forwarding one from Mr. Nicol together with amended preliminary freeboard report on the Steamers "CLAN MACNAB", "CLAN MACNAIR", "CLAN MACNEIL" and "CLAN MACNAUGHTON", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that, provided the vessels be altered in accordance with the plan as submitted, and the particulars and dimensions now supplied be verified on the completion of the alterations, the amended freeboards set forth in the enclosed memorandum could be recommended for the approval of the Committee, subject to efficient temporary covers being fitted to the tonnage opening as required by the Rules for Shelter Deck Steamers.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Builders accordingly.

When the alterations are completed, the reports of survey should be forwarded as early as possible, in order that freeboards may be assigned by the Committee in sufficient time for the same to be marked and the certificates issued before the vessels leave your port.
