With reference to your letter of the 22nd instant respecting the question of the freeboards of the Steamers "CLAN MACNAB", "CLAN MACNEIL", "CLAN MACNAIR" and "CLAN MACNAUGHTON", I have to state that the Builders have submitted an amended plan of the shelter deck, showing the ^{tonnage} opening, on which they have indicated a bulkhead at the after end of the opening in addition to the one at the forward end as shown on the previous plan.

In accordance with the new arrangements, I have prepared an amended freeboard report which is submitted for the consideration of the Committee, and the Builders will be glad to have amended figures of freeboard as soon as convenient.
