

Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of yesterday's date forwarding one from Mr. Nicol together with preliminary freeboard report on the steamers "CLAN MACNAB", "CLAN MACNAIR", "CLAN MACNEIL" and "CLAN MACNAUGHTON", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that, provided the vessels be altered in accordance with the plan as submitted, and the particulars and dimensions now supplied be verified on the completion of the alterations, the freeboards set forth in the enclosed memorandum could be recommended for the approval of the Committee, subject to efficient temporary covers being fitted to the tonnage opening as required by the Rules for shelter deck steamers.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Builders accordingly.

When the alterations are completed, the report of survey should be forwarded as early as possible, in order that freeboards may be assigned by the Committee in sufficient time for the same to be marked and the certificate issued before the vessel leaves your port.
