With reference to the assignment of a freeboard nine feet six inches to the above vessel (London letter of the 26th ultimo) and following upon correspondence which we have had with Mr. Watt, together with the receipt of a telegram from London on the 30th ultimo, reading as follows:-

" "CLAN MACNAB" if hatch webs strengthened equal rule freeboard could be eight feet eight inches approximate,"
to state that the Builders have now added heavy rider ribs as suggested to the bottom of the hatchway webs in the 2,3,& 4 hatchways, making them equivalent to rule requirements.

I, therefore, return herewith the certificates forwarded of the 26th ultimo for cancellation at the request of the Builders, and await an assignment corresponding with the alterations made.

Enclosed please find midship section of vessel as shown together with original section and amended 'tween deck structure particulars received from the Board of Trade yesterday, which please return.
