the 26th ultimo) and following upon correspondence which
we have had with Mr. Watt, together with the receipt of a
telegram from London on the 30th ultimo, reading as follows:-


" "CLAN MACNAB" if hatch webs strengthened equal rule
freeboard could be eight feet eight inches approximate,
....."
to state that the Builders have now added heavy rider
as suggested to the bottom of the hatchway webs in the
2,3,& 4 hatchways, making them equivalent to rule requirements.

I, therefore, return herewith the certificates forwarded
the 26th ultimo for cancellation at the request of the Builders,
await an assignment corresponding with the alterations made.
