With reference to your request that a Freeboard be assigned by the Committee of this Society to the S. "CLAN MACNAB", your Yard No. 485, I am directed to acquaint you that they have assigned to her freeboard as set forth below, in accordance with the rules referred to in the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894, and request that you will kindly inform me when and at what port it will be marked on the vessel's sides, as shown by diagram on the other side, in order that the Society's surveyors may be instructed to report the fact promptly, with a view to a certificate of freeboard being issued and record thereof made in the Society's Register Book.
