Sirs,

With reference to your request that a Freeboard be assigned by the Committee of this Society to the S. "CLAN MACNAB", your Yard No. 485, I am directed to acquaint you that they have assigned to her freeboard as set forth below, in accordance with the rules referred to in the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894, and I request that you will kindly inform me when and at what place it will be marked on the vessel's sides, as shown by the diagram on the other side, in order that the Society's Surveyors may be instructed to report the fact promptly, with a view to a certificate of freeboard being issued and recorded thereof made in the Society's Register Book.

- HEIGHT OF DISC..... 9 ft. 6 ins. below top of statutory deck line.
- MINIMUM LOAD-LINE in fresh water..... 7 inches above the centre of the disc.
- "    in Indian Seas in Summer..... 6 inches above the centre of the disc.
- "    in Summer the centre of the disc.
- "    in Winter..... 6 inches below the centre of the disc.
- "    in Winter, North Atlantic..... inches below the centre of the disc.

the hatch webs in Nos. 2, 3 & 4 hatchways are made equivalent to the Rule requirements.
