Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith Freeboard Verification Form for S.S.  
"COULTARN".

As desired in the Assignment Letter, I have to state that an additional tarpaulin is being fitted to the coal hatchway on the casing top, and side scuttles 9" diameter are fitted in the poop accommodation aft of substantial construction and fitted with permanently attached deadlights. It is regretted that this was omitted from the report.

An alteration has been made to the ventilator to the tunnel reported on the upper deck aft. A steel trunk 9" x 18" and 7'3" in height has been built on the fore side of the steering gear house slightly starboard of the centre line and the existing coaming 30" x .32" fitted on top. The closing appliances of this coaming remain the same.

I shall be glad if this amendment can be made to the  
C.11 Report.
