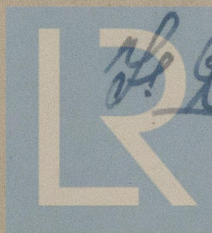
have to report that I found Main Topmast decayed on
 the Port Side. Fore and Main Topmast Backstays
 Port and Starboard. Wasted and Fitted above
 the service. Lower Part of N^o 4 Shroud in
 the Starboard. Fore Rigging. Broken.
 Recommend the renewal of the above.
 Lower screw eyes and shackles of all
 rigging. Backstays and Fore and aft-
 stays. Worn in the hips. Recommend the
 shide to be fired, made workable and repaired
 where necessary. Mast, other spars, Rigging
 Ironwork in good condition.
