Electrical Installation.  
-----

The plans indicate fuses of Messrs. A.E.G. and Fabricaat Odink and Koenderink manufacture. These fuses have not been generally approved, but the construction has been examined and in view of the small size of the generators it is considered the fuses might be accepted in this instance.

IT IS SUBMITTED that, provided the installation be as shown and amended on the plans and to the Surveyors' satisfaction and the remaining requirements of the Rules for Electrical Equipment be complied with, the plans merit approval.

It should be pointed out that in view of the small size of the generators, no exception will be taken in this instance to the use of the proposed fuses of Messrs. A.E.G. and Fabricaat Odink and Koenderink, indicated on the plan.

It is concluded the  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mm. cables on the lighting circuits are protected by double pole fuses on the sub-distribution board in accordance with Section 7, Clause 2(a), of the Rules. This should be confirmed.
