Dear Sirs,

I have to inform you that Convention freeboards were assigned to the "EMINENT", built at Groningen, and I am now advised by the Groningen Surveyor that she is now owned by "ARMACO", Armement Maritime et Cotier S.A. Antwerp, address: Societe d'Expédition & de Navigation "Nevex", S.A., Oudaenstraat 18, Antwerp.

I therefore enclose a Belgian Load Line Certificate and copy for endorsement by the Belgian Authorities and issued when the freeboards have been verified, the name of the ship and signal letters inserted, particulars of which should be sent to this Office and when the Authorities are satisfied with the arrangement of freeing ports for the dispersion of water shipped in the forward well. An extra copy is also sent for the Authorities, together with copies of the Rpt.C11 and Rpt.C11(comp). The dates of issue and expiry should also be inserted and this Office advised.
