REEBOARD REPORT on the

S/S ILLINOIS now Mount Pentelikon

It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those required by the Tables, merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to

- (1) Suitable provision being made for rigging lifelines which should be available for use in all parts of the vessel which might have to be used by the crew in the regular working thereof.
- (2) Two sets of ladders & efficient battery arrangements being provided for the hatch on the Forecastle & the Small hatch & the Deck Ports if this is not already the case.
- (3) All the requirements of the special survey for reclassification being carried out to the surveyor's satisfaction.
