I am pleased if you will forward any deferred reports

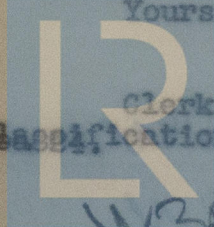
I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant respecting the steamer "ILLINOIS", the contents of which have been noted, and, as requested by you I enclose the undermentioned reports on the vessel for your information and guidance in dealing with the case.

In this connection I have to inform you that no part of the hull survey has been held and that to entitle the vessel to have her class re-instated in the Register Book it will be necessary for the full Requirements of the 2nd Special Survey No. 1 to be carried out. The Boiler Survey which has been recently carried out at Brest has, however, been accepted as part of the reclassification survey. At the same time I enclose an extract of particulars from the previous freeboard report for your guidance in carrying out the survey of the Assignment of Convention Freeboard measurements.
