In September 1920 the Class #100AI was withdrawn at the Owners' request.

The greater part (approximately 60%) of a Reclassification Survey, S.S. No. 3, was held at Baltimore in May last, and the Survey has now been slightly advanced at Manchester.

The fee for the Reclassification Survey, in accordance with the approved American scale, is 525\$, and for the part Survey at Baltimore the proportionate fee is 320\$, say, £80.

If the Survey had been held entirely in this country, the fee, in accordance with the usual practice of the Committee, would be £57.10.0, and a proportionate fee for the work done here would be about £20.

It is submitted that as regards the hull, a fee of £80 be charged now, the balance of £20 to be charged when the Survey is completed.

As regards the machinery only the screw shaft was examined at Baltimore. The Boiler Survey and part of the Engine Survey and the Electrical Survey have been held now at Manchester.

The fee for Reclassification of machinery is £28, and in addition a fee of double the Rule Special Survey fee is chargeable for the Survey of the Electrical equipment. — 4

It is submitted £18. be charged now, together with the fee for survey of electrical equipment, leaving £10. to be charged later.

In a letter, dated 5th July last, Mr. Bennett wrote that it was possible that he might be able to collect on that side the expenses incurred by the Baltimore Surveyors on account of the part survey of the Hull and Machinery, amounting to 47\$ (£11.15.0), and that he was taking steps towards that end.
