Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of your letter of the 15th instant regarding the S.S. "PROCIDA" to be presented for Reclassification, and as advised we will consider the case in the light of instructions given for ex Danish vessels, but hold a Loadline Annual Survey since it would be inconvenient to carry out a complete Special Survey at this time.

We enclose meantime the existing Freeboard Certificate, Certificate of Class and Freeboard Verification Form. It is the present intention to place the vessel in dry dock when the cargo is discharged. The new name and Port of Registry are not yet available.

We might mention that discharging arrangements and time required to fit guns may occasion greater delay than at first anticipated and perhaps you will indicate whether the longer time available might modify your instructions.
