We also have instructions to carry out a Load Line Survey and shall be glad to have extract from previous Freeboard Report for our information.

The Managers have been informed that the survey necessary for reclassification will be equal to a 2nd. Special Survey No.3, and arrangements are being made accordingly.

*c 1764* The vessel is at present discharging cargo and it is desired that she should be placed in commission immediately, and with this in view the Controller of Repairs has requested the minimum degree of opening up necessary for the issue of Provisional Certificates and we shall be glad to have your instructions on this matter.
