OAK WOOD.

It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying

form, being those required by the Tables, merit approval, Subject to

- 1 The toggles on the fidley storm covers being to the Surveyor's satisfaction.
- 2 Any companionways on the Poop Deck complying reasonably with the requirements of the Rules
- 3 The ventilator coamings being provided with efficient closing arrangements, the thicknesses of the coamings complying with the Rule requirements, the ventilator coaming 4'-0" high on the main Deck forward being specially supported and secured and any ventilators on the Poop complying reasonably in all respects with the requirements of the Rules.
- 4 The air pipes having efficient means of closing and they air-pipes on the Poop complying in all respects with the requirements of the Rules.
- 5 The sidelight in the Bosun's room being to the Surveyor's satisfaction.
- 6 Suitable provision being made for rigging lifelines which should be available for use in all parts of the ship which might have to be used by the crew in the regular working thereof.
- 7 ~~The hatchway beams on No 3 hatch having Rule scantlings~~
