Dear Mr. Mayne,

I have to confirm the telegram sent to
you this morning reading as follows:-

"GAASTERDIJK", Report 42046, is fifth of series six
"similar jobs. No certificates forwarded here previous
"cases, Reports 40599, 40768, 41661. Brown not
"expected to raise question if certificates sent Rotterdam".

The official telegram was received here
about 4.30 p.m. yesterday, and the reply from Messrs. John
Brown & Co., Ltd. was received too late to wire last evening.
Messrs. Brown & Co's Secretary explained that they were only
sub-contractors to Messrs. Harland & Wolff, Belfast, and would
give no opinion whether or not the certificates could be sent
to Rotterdam. He pointed out that in the previous cases
the certificates had not been sent to them and no question had
been raised, either by Messrs. Brown or Messrs. Harland & Wolff,
and it was unlikely to be in this instance.

Mr. Warlow is busy to-day with election
work and requested me to write you as above.
