This vessel was built at Bremen in 1907 and is at present classed with the British Corporation.

With a view to classification with this Society particulars of scantlings and other details shown on a first entry report have been approved.

The Rotterdam, Cardiff and Liverpool Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and the requirements of a S.S.No.3 complied with and minor repairs effected and the bottom cleaned and coated.

Some repairs are required in the bunkers and 15 fathoms of chain cable requires to be supplied.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 100A1 with record of survey 8,27.Rot. and notation of S.S.Liv.No.3-3,27, subject to repairs being effected in the bunkers and to 15 fathoms of chain cable of proper size, weight and test being supplied at the first convenient opportunity.
