Attended by request to examine no 2 double bottom tank internally & found it unprepared & to have mud & water all over the bottom. no examination could be made. also asked to see nos. 1 & 6 fallst tanks under pressure with about 1" of the tank top ceiling lifted & limber boards up. the tanks were tight, the tank tops & bilges require sealing. nothing further was done as the vessel proceeded to load.
