We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the instant respecting the S.S. "FOYNES", and have to confirm our telegram to you today as follows:- "FOYNES 21120 ALPHA 1250 BETA 1265 GAMMA 10 POINT 8."

"FOYNES" = Vessel's name.

21120 = Number in Register Book.

ALPHA 1250 = Moulded displacement at a moulded draught equal to 85% of the moulded depth.

BETA 1265 = External displacement at extreme draught of 14'-0"

GAMMA 10.8 = Tons per inch immersion.
