- "FOYNES" = Vessel's name.
- 21120 = Number in Register Book.
- ALPHA 1250 = Moulded displacement at a moulded draught equal to 85% of the moulded depth.
- BETA 1265 = External displacement at extreme draught of 14'-0"
- GAMMA 10.8 = Tons per inch immersion.
