With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "FRANCES MASSEY", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had before them a report received from the Society's Surveyor at Hull from which it appears the vessel has been examined as far as practicable afloat after grounding.

So far as could be seen no damage had been sustained but it is recommended the vessel be further examined at the next drydocking.

The Boiler Survey has also been <sup>partly</sup> held on this occasion and to complete this inspection the starboard and centre boilers require to be examined and all the safety valves adjusted.
