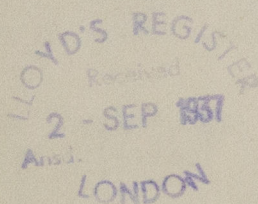

With reference to your letter of the 31st ultimo regarding our Report C.11 on the steam tug "ENGLISHMAN", the following information is forwarded as requested.

1. The moulded displacement at moulded draught = 85% of moulded depth is 887 tons.
2. The extreme displacement and tons per inch immersion at moulded draught = 14'-7" are 982 tons and 7.8 tons per inch respectively.
3. The length of unsheathed deck aft measured from the AP. is 9'0".
