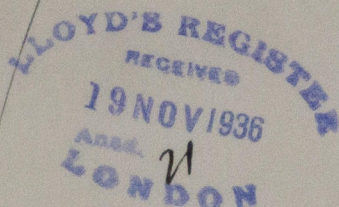

We enclose herewith a letter received to-day from Messrs. The United Towing Co., Ltd., requesting a provisional freeboard assignment for a proposed ocean going tug of which particulars are given.

A report on Form C.11 is enclosed embodying the available particulars, and the Owners respectfully request that early attention be given to the case.

It is also stated that the vessel's scantlings will be considerably above Rule requirements, e.g. the sheerstrake to be in excess 100% and shell and framing about 25%.
