To complete the survey on the hull the following remains to be done, as per First Entry Report :-

- "Casings; top of boiler casing to be made. Engine
- "skylight to be riveted. Tunnel plate to be riveted.
- "Windlass and steering gear to be tested under steam.
- "Boiler bearers to rivet".

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to give the case the necessary attention, and, on completion of the work, to forward a report on form No. 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
