PROVISIONAL LOAD LINE CERTIFICATE.

This is to Certify that

PETER F. BALFOUR,

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners survey the steel screw steamer "ROSSOULA", 1282 tons gross of Panama, No. 88069 in the supplement to the Register Book for Periodical Load Line survey whilst lying afloat in the Harbour of Piraeus.

All recommendations having been satisfactorily completed, this Provisional Certificate is issued, valid until 5th September 1939, pending the issue of a new Panamanian Load Line Certificate.

The freeboards as originally assigned by the Committee of Lloyd's Register of shipping have now been verified, and found correctly marked on the vessel's sides, as hereunder:-
