The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to shell plate B4 from aft (set up) starboard and indented bridge side plating etc., port side, abreast main mast, being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The Surveyors appointed by Lloyd's Agents at San Pedro, now report the vessel examined afloat after grounding.

No appreciable leakage was found and, in the Surveyors' opinion the vessel is fit to load her cargo of sugar and proceed to her destination.

They recommend further examination in dry dock on completion of the present voyage.

It is submitted action be deferred.
