This vessel stranded off Rio de Janeiro in June
1941 when extensive damage was sustained and although

some repairs were carried out to enable her to be sailed

S. Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the request
contained in your letter of the 13th instant respecting
the "CAPRERA" now to be renamed "ARABUTAN" was
submitted to the Committee here today, and in reply I
am desired to point out that from the returns received
periodically from the Society's Surveyor at Rio de
Janeiro, it appears that this vessel has been under
his survey for the past twelve months for a major
inspection, namely, Second Special Survey No.3, with
a view to reclassification in the Society's Register
Book.

No details of the repairs to the extensive
damage reported some years ago as the result of stranding
have yet been received, but with a view to helping you
as far as possible a cablegram has been sent to the
Surveyor asking whether he can furnish any estimate
of the cost of the repairs which are apparently being
carried out in this case.

Immediately upon the receipt of his reply
I will again communicate with you.
