

Steamer "CAPRERA"

This vessel stranded off Rio de Janeiro in June 1932 when extensive damage was sustained and although some repairs were carried out to enable her to be taken

out of dry dock she was made a CTL and afterwards bought

by Mr. Pedro Luiz Correa e Castro of **WOKINGHAM COPY.**

A notation of "Stranded 6.32 - Refloated - now

in port" was assigned by the Committee in March 1933,

but towards the end of last year the vessel was brought

to the Repairs Works at Ilha do Vianna for the purpose

of reconditioning and reclassification, a request having **14. 10. 4**
