S I am very pleased to learn from your cablegram of the 16th instant that it is proposed to submit the steamer "CAPRERA" for re-classification with this Society. In the circumstances, I cabled to you as per copy enclosed, from which you will observe that for re-instatement of class it will be necessary for a Second Special Survey No. 3 to be held.

I would, at the same time, confirm the following thicknesses of shell plating, viz:-

Keel	1 inch	to .72
Bottom	.62	to .46
Sides	.62	to .44
L Strake	.72	to .46
M "	.86	to .46
N "	.64	to .46
O "	.66	to .46

The cost of my cabled instructions was £2. 6. 6d., and I shall be glad if you will kindly arrange for this amount to be included in your official account and credited to this Office.
