GANDARA.—Gibraltar, Apr. 4. — The de-
stroyer Winchelsea, which has been stand-
ing by the steamer Gandara (ashore on
the Morocco coast near Tangier) has
arrived at Gibraltar from the stranded
vessel. The thirty tons of silver bar,
valued at £80,000, and a box of gold
leaf, of value unknown, which were in the
Gandara, have now been transferred to
the strong room of Messrs. M. H. Bland
& Co., Ltd., who are in charge of the
salvage operations. The Gandara was
this afternoon reported to have been re-
floated.—Reuter.

Gibraltar, Apr. 4.—Steamer

GANDARA. — London, Apr. 11. — The
owners report, under date of Apr. 7:
Steamer Gandara, which grounded off
Point Cires on the Moroccan coast, has
been temporarily repaired and taken
into Gibraltar, where it will be neces-
sary to discharge approximately 4000
tons deadweight of cargo for drydocking.
This cargo will be reshipped, with the
cargo which was discharged while the
vessel was aground, when the necessary
repairs have been done to enable her to
proceed to her destination. It is hoped
that she will be ready to proceed in
about a month.
