REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage stated to have been caused by Collision with the SS City of Rhios off the Hebrides on 20th August 1940

Damage was found to have been sustained on the Port Side aft abeam the mainmast. Nos. 4 & 8 sheerstrake plates from aft. were set in & h<sup>o</sup> 4 fractured between rivets on inner edge. Nos 6 & 7 plates in the 1<sup>st</sup> Strake below sheerstrake were also set in. Deck stringer plate & 2 adjacent plates were buckled & a number of frames, beam ends, & knees buckled.
