Dear Sirs,

A. With reference to your first entry report No. 10931 on the Steamer "HURUNUI" (ex "NORFOLK") which it is noted from the fee entered on the report has been completed as a Standard vessel, and to the pencilled note thereon to the effect that the fees will be applied for from London, I have to inform you with regard thereto that in accordance with Circular No. 1307 the fees for Standard Vessels were payable by the Builders. You will see on reference to the Circular in question that it was specifically stated that it was desired by the Department of the Shipping Controller that the existing practice as to the mode of rendering accounts should be continued to be followed.

In these circumstances you will be good enough to render your account for the fees due in this case to the Builders in the usual way.
