RETAIN

A. With reference to your letter of the 20th instant, respecting the turbine machinery made by Messrs. Richardsons, Westgarth & Co., Ltd., for Messrs. Sir R. Dixon & Co's No. 596 vessel, I have to inform you that as in this case the special duties with regard to the specification are being carried out to the completion of the vessel, the fees should be charged as for a Standard vessel, viz:- at 1/4 per gross ton, and an account for the proportion of this fee, as per Circular No. 307, should be rendered by you to the Engineers.

As it will be necessary for the gross tonnage of the vessel to be ascertained before the fee can be applied for, you will be good enough to place yourselves in communication with the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough in regard to the matter.
