With reference to the freeboard of S.S. "NORFOLK",  
Messrs. Sir. Raylton Dixon & Co's 596a, reported in our report  
10646, assigned in your letter of 27th. April, and marking  
cancelled on 12th. May 1920, and of which the certificates  
have been received in this Office, I beg to state that the  
Board of Trade have re-measured this Ship in consequence of  
their decision not to insulate her, and the resulting Under Deck  
space is somewhat greater than that previously communicated  
to you.

I therefore enclose a supplementary list of  
particulars on Form 11c and return the freeboard certificates  
for cancellation.

It will be observed that the name of this vessel  
is now "HURUNUI".

enclosed for reference.


