A further report of a survey held by Lloyd's Agents at Freetown, Sierra Leone, has been received.

The Surveyor states that one of the thrust shoes is cracked and he recommends it be renewed and the other thrust shoes remetalled.

He also recommends repairs to the circulating pump engine and that the other parts of the main engine be opened up for examination.

The vessel was apparently still under ^{repair} survey at that port.

It is submitted action be deferred and a report awaited.
