DAMAGE.

Survey

The Milford Haven Surveyors report this vessel examined afloat on account of damage through collision.

In way of the starboard bow 2 fore-castle side plates, fore-castle deck stringer plating, fore-castle framing and bulkheads and starboard bulwarks in forward well set in.

The Surveyors state the efficiency of the vessel is not impaired by damage.

No Temporary repairs have been effected to their satisfaction, the Surveyors recommend permanent repairs at the Owners' convenience.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as recommended.
