Deck forced up in 11 different places,  
2 deep corrugations right across deck, sides  
corrugated from deck to bilge, and in the bottom  
from amidships forward nearly every plate  
corrugated and all holds set-up.

She was abandoned as a constructive  
total loss. She was subsequently refloated, towed  
to Swansea and sold for breaking up.

In a letter dated 22nd Ultimo,  
the Swansea Surveyors state that the work of  
demolition is now in hand.
