EEBOARD REPORT on the

The Hull Surveyors telephoned this office late yesterday afternoon to the effect that the Board of Trade had held the ship up pending the Biannual load line survey being carried out.

The master of the ship stated that the survey had been carried out but the Surveyors had omitted to endorse the Certificate.

Mr MacKintosh was advised to arrange for the Owners to obtain permission from the local Council for the Society's Surveyors to carry out the survey and endorse the Certificate. A copy of the present Certificate on board was issued by the Greek Government at Piræus on April 1936.

The Surveyors were advised by phone to-day to proceed with the survey and examine the ship in relation to the requirements of the International Convention & then satisfied to endorse the Certificate. L.W.B. 25/1/39. S.L.R.
