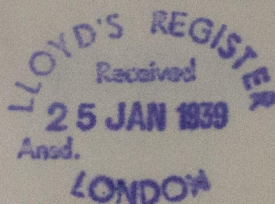

postal survey 325 No. 1.


Her freboard certificate was
