Below the application form & beg to acquaint  
that the fore end of the poop is closed -  
after end of Bridge is fitted for weather boards  
at height the angle iron for same being bolted  
the casing inside house -  
fore end of Bridge has an iron door 4'-6" x 3'-0"  
with three iron hinges on back & is secured with  
heavy nuts spaced 15" apart -  
stiffening of the bridge post could not be  
as hatches are in good order.


